- Parent Cafés

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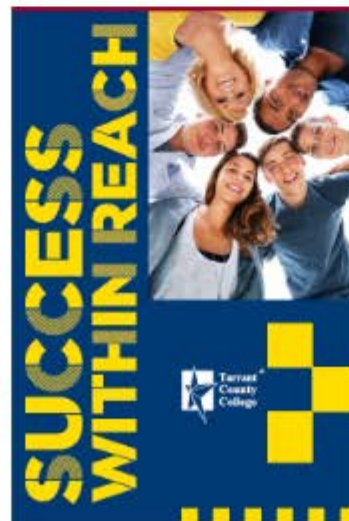
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TCC 101 & Interest Card

TSI Assessment

What is TSI?

A state required computerized assessment that measures your college readiness in reading, writing and mathematics. The TSI Assessment is a PLACEMENT exam, not a pass/fail test.

All TCC new-to-college-students are required to take a placement test (unless you have met SAT/ACT exemption) to help academic advisors correctly place you in courses in which you will be successful.

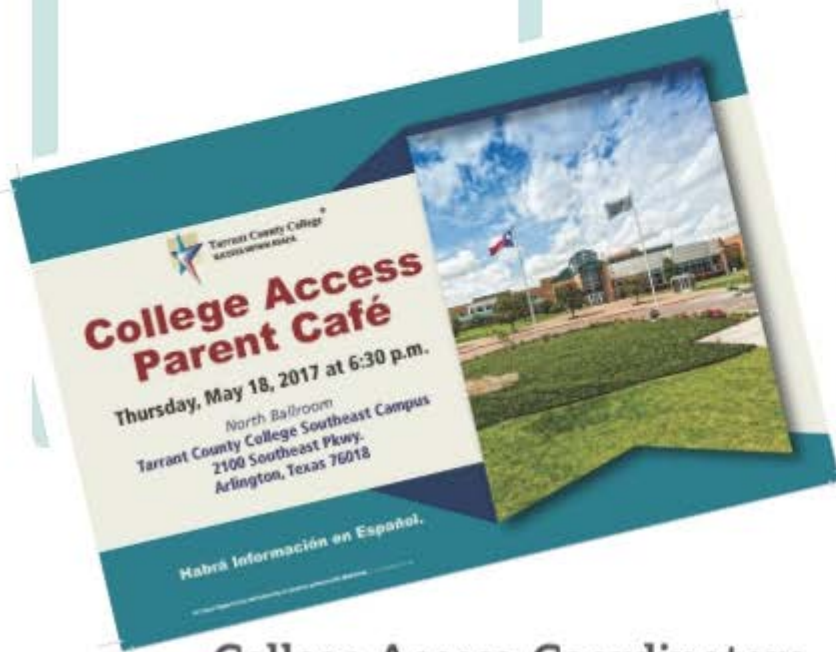

Why do I have to take the TSI?

Submit Required Supporting Documents

- 1** Official High School Transcript/GED
- 2** Official transcript from each accredited college/university previously attended
- 3** Scores for approved placement test taken at other college/university (ACT, SAT, etc.)
- 4** Residency documentation (if needed)
- 5** Meningitis shot record
