

### TSI Assessment

What is TSI?

A state required computerized assessment that measures your college readiness in reading, writing and mathematics. The TSI Assessment is a PLACEMENT exam, not a pass/fail test.

All TCC new-to-college-students are required to take a placement test (unless you have met SAT/ACT exemption) to help academic advisors correctly place you in courses in which you will be succeessful.

### Submit Required Supporting Documents

- Official High School Transcript/GED
- Official transcript from each accredited college/university previously attended
- Scores for approved placement test taken at other college/university (ACT, SAT, etc.)
- Residency documentation (if needed)
- Meningitis shot record
